

Part 6: Timeliness of Grades

Quality Benchmark: LCME requires that all grades be visible to students prior to 6 weeks from the last day of the clerkship. For the surgery clerkship, the average time for students to receive grades is 5 weeks 4 days. Below is a graph that compares surgery to other required clerkships.
