

Logging and Review: Students are required to log their clinical encounters and skills. All expected content is reviewed during orientation and again at mid-year. The UCR School of Medicine utilizes New Innovations for case logging. Students review clinical encounters with the clerkship directors at weeks seven, 14 and 21. If there are cases where significant gaps exist, clerkship directors work with students to identify a work plan that will allow students to meet expectations.
